



## Saint Sophia Dress Code 2010-2011

Uniforms are required for students in Kindergarten and above. They are optional for the Early Childhood Program. **Full-dress uniforms must be worn every time there are church services, Mondays, and school outings unless notified otherwise.**

### **Full-Dress Uniform consists of:**

#### **GIRLS**

- McBeth Plaid jumper, skirt or skort
- Tights, leggings, socks: plain red, white, navy or black only.
- Plain white, dress blouse with Peter-Pan collar or with button-down collar or with blue piping on collar; tucked in. Short or long sleeves. (No knit blouses or turtlenecks.)
- **Plain black, navy, or brown Dress shoes or Dress boots**
- Plain solid navy sweater, *when needed*
- 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> grade only: blue sweater with St. Sophia emblem

**Hair accessories** – McBeth plaid or plain black, navy, red, yellow or white colors

#### **BOYS**

- Plain navy walking pants
- White Oxford shirt, tucked into pants with uniform tie
- Plain white, navy, or black socks
- Plain black, navy, or brown belt
- Plain navy sweater or vest, *when needed*
- 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> grades only: blue sweater with St. Sophia emblem
- Navy blue, brown or black *Dress shoes*

### **Daily uniform consists of:**

- Plain navy pants or walking shorts
- Navy blue skort (for girls)
- White, navy, red or yellow shirt with collar (these may be knit-polo shirts or turtlenecks, short or long sleeve)
- Plain white, navy, red or black socks, tights, or leggings
- Athletic shoes with non-marking rubber soles
- Plain solid, navy, red or white sweater (cardigan, v-neck, or vest)
- Plain black, navy or brown belt with pants or shorts
- White polo shirt with St. Sophia logo
- Gray or navy blue hooded or pull-over sweatshirt with St. Sophia logo on it. (from Dennis Uniform or SPA, a logo can be embroidered on at Karen Pullman's Pro Shop)

Students should arrive at school dressed appropriately for the weather.

**No:** Zip-offs, cargo, sweat pants or jeans
